



**Fredericton, NB
Air Traffic Control Service to be Implemented in Fredericton**

NAV CANADA, the country's provider of civil air navigation services, has reviewed the requirement for Air Traffic Services at the airport in Fredericton, NB. Given continued air traffic growth at the airport, NAV CANADA has decided to take the necessary steps to transition from a Flight Service Station (FSS) at the Fredericton facility.

The transition will take place in several phases. Initially, beginning December 17th 2009, air traffic control service will be provided for 8 hours from 0800 hours (local time) until 1600 hours, with airport advisory service continuing to be provided outside of the control hours. As staffing levels rise, the hours of control service will be expanded.

Airspace classification will change from 'E' to 'D' during tower hours of operation and expand in conjunction with tower hours.

Additional information on the implementation schedule will be provided when available.

This change will take effect December 17, 2009 at 0901 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC).
The appropriate aeronautical publications will be amended.
