



NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE IN CONTROL RESPONSIBILITY IN NORTH-WESTERN SASKATCHEWAN

NAV CANADA, the country's provider of civil air navigation services, will be changing responsibility for providing air traffic control services in the airspace in the vicinity of Uranium City and Stony Rapids, Saskatchewan.

Taking into consideration the flow of air traffic and the complexity and nature of operations in North-western Saskatchewan, NAV CANADA has concluded that the air traffic control services from level FL180 to below FL290, and Air Traffic Services provided below FL180, currently provided by the Edmonton Area Control Centre (ACC), should be provided by Winnipeg ACC.

As a result, commencing **3 June 2010**, all airspace from level FL180 to below FL290 in the area bounded by a line beginning at N59 41 13.28 W98 05 32.93 to N61 48 00 W110 00 00 to N58 24 10 W110 00 00 to N56 33 58 W 107 28 35 to N55 20 00 W109 40 00 then clockwise along a 60 miles arc centred on Cold Lake, AB TACAN to N54 46 00 W108 41 40 thence easterly along the Edmonton/Winnipeg FIR boundary to the point of beginning will be the responsibility of Winnipeg ACC. Pilots wishing to operate in this airspace are to contact Winnipeg ACC on **124.475 MHZ** prior to entry into the airspace.

These changes will take effect 03 June 2010 at 0901 Coordinated Universal Time. The appropriate aeronautical publications will be amended.
