

AIP CANADA (ICAO) SUPPLEMENT 37/12

BLASTING ZONE—BLOODVEIN, MANITOBA

For the next 5 to 6 years there will be sporadic quarry operations, including blasting along this right-of-way (depicted as a purple line in the included graphic), at various locations and times. The blasting height is 1,200 ft above ground level (AGL), or 2,000 ft above sea level (ASL).

Blasting activities will be within the area (depicted as a red box in the included graphic) bounded by:

52° 21' 05" N	096° 53' 17" W	to
52° 12' 42" N	097° 03' 07" W	to
51° 09' 27" N	096° 21' 50" W	to
51° 05' 57" N	096° 07' 20" W	to point of origin.

The approximate centre of this blasting activity (51° 43' 31" N 096° 35' 13" W) is located 5 nautical miles (NM) southeast (SE) of the Bloodvein River Airport (CZTA), and 41 NM south southeast (SSE) of the Berens River Airport (CYBV).

Details of any procedure changes implemented because of this blasting activity will be promulgated via NOTAM, publication amendment, or both.
