

## AIP CANADA (ICAO) SUPPLEMENT 71/14

### MULTIPLE CRANES—TORONTO, ONTARIO

Until 30 April 2018, multiple cranes will be erected in Toronto, Ontario. The maximum height is 784 feet above ground level (AGL), or 1,035 feet above sea level (ASL). The structures will be lighted, but not painted.

The cranes will be located within a 240 foot radius of the following coordinates:


43° 38' 28.22" N 79° 22' 52.66" W

These cranes are approximately 0.7 nautical miles (NM) east northeast (ENE) of Toronto / Billy Bishop Toronto City Airport (Water) (CPZ9). Details of any procedure changes implemented due to this crane activity will be promulgated via NOTAM, publication amendment, or both.
