

# AIP CANADA (ICAO) SUPPLEMENT 13/15

## MULTIPLE CRANES—TORONTO, ONTARIO

Multiple cranes will be erected in Toronto, Ontario. The maximum height is 918 feet above ground level (AGL) or 1,170 feet above sea level (ASL). The structures will be lighted.

Tower Crane 1	43° 38' 30.8246" N 79° 22' 46.3249" W	840 feet AGL	1,092 feet mean sea level (MSL) Operating within a 132 foot radius
Tower Crane 2	43° 38' 30.7097" N 79° 22' 44.2420" W	918 feet AGL	1,170 feet MSL Operating within a 165 foot radius

The cranes are approximately 0.7 nautical miles (NM) south southwest (SSW) of Toronto St. Michael's Hospital Heliport (CTM4). Details of any procedure changes implemented due to this crane activity will be promulgated via NOTAM, publication amendment, or both.
