

AIP CANADA (ICAO) SUPPLEMENT 35/16

CLOSING OF THE MASCOUCHE AIRPORT (CSK3)

The Mascouche airport (CSK3) will cease its operations on 15 November 2016 at 23h59 local time.

All types of flight operations from or to CSK3 will be forbidden from that point on. The runways will be identified as inoperable with markings and will not be inspected or maintained from then on. Anyone foregoing the above is exposed to penal and/or criminal prosecutions.

Aircraft permanently based at the Mascouche airport will have to leave the premises no later than 13 November 2016 at sundown. Once an aircraft has taken off, it will not be allowed to return to CSK3, except in case of an immediate in-flight emergency following take-off.

No flight operations from CSK3 will be allowed during the period of 13 November 2016 at sundown until 15 November 2016 at 23h59 local time, except with written authorization from the airport authority.

Aircraft unable to leave the grounds of CSK3 at the time of closing on 15 November 2016 at 23h59 local time will need to be removed by ground means no later than 14 December 2016 at 23h59 local time.

It will be important to check the NOTAM files during this whole process of closing.
