

AIP CANADA (ICAO) SUPPLEMENT 38/16

QUEBEC REGION MONTRÉAL/ST-HUBERT AIRPORT (CYHU) CONSTRUCTION WORK OCTOBER 13, 2016–DECEMBER 1, 2016

From October 13, 2016, to December 1, 2016, major construction work affecting Runway 06L/24R and Taxiways CHARLIE, MIKE and ROMEO will take place. The purpose of the project is to restore the storm water drainage network, the related visual aids and the lighting systems (e.g. runway and taxiway edge lighting, runway threshold lighting, signage lighting, precision approach path indicators [PAPIs], runway identification lights [RILS], simplified short approach lighting system with runway alignment indicator lights [SSALR] and wind direction indicators).

Runway 06L/24R will remain operational with width reductions during daylight hours and will be closed at night. Taxiways CHARLIE (between Taxiway MIKE and the threshold of Runway 24R), MIKE and ROMEO will be closed during the construction work.

Check applicable NOTAMs prior to conducting flight operations at this airport.
