INSTRUMENT LANDING SYSTEM (ILS) REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

(Replaces AIC 5/14)

In accordance with NAV CANADA's Air Navigation System Plan (ANS Plan) and as part of life-cycle management, NAV CANADA will be continuing in 2015 with the national instrument landing system (ILS) replacement program.

During the replacement period, ILS availability at the location where the replacement is taking place will be affected for approximately one to three months, depending on weather and installation factors. As well, new ILS systems do not generate a useable back-course signal; consequently, localizer back-course procedures will be replaced with GNSS approaches, where applicable.

Actual dates of scheduled outages will be published via NOTAM. Pilots should carefully monitor NOTAMs before and during the construction period for specific dates of outages or other related disruptions.
