



NOTICE OF CHANGE

REMOTE COMMUNICATIONS OUTLETS CLOSURE OF NORTH BAY FLIGHT INFORMATION CENTRE (ARCTIC RADIO)

The North Bay Flight Information Centre (FIC) / Arctic Radio is being closed. Consequently, NAV CANADA will no longer have access to the Department of National Defense (DND) remote communications outlets (RCOs). To ensure that the required Flight Information Service Enroute (FISE) RCO coverage is provided, new NAV CANADA FISE RCOs will be installed across the Arctic. Following is a summary of the changes:
