

## AIP CANADA (ICAO) SUPPLEMENT 83/19

### MULTIPLE CRANES—MISSISSAUGA, ONTARIO

Multiple cranes will be erected in Mississauga, Ontario. The maximum height is 565 feet above ground level (AGL) or 1,024 feet above sea level (ASL). The structures will be lighted, but not painted.

The cranes will be located within a 254-foot radius centred at the following coordinates:

43° 35' 23" N 79° 37' 55" W

Multiple cranes are approximately 5 nautical miles (NM) south (S) of Toronto/Lester B. Pearson International Airport (CYYZ) and 3 NM west southwest (WSW) of Toronto/Wilson's Heliport (CPY5). Details of any procedure changes implemented due to this crane activity will be promulgated via NOTAM, publication amendment, or both.
