

AIP CANADA (ICAO) SUPPLEMENT 11/20

MULTIPLE CRANES—TORONTO, ONTARIO

Multiple cranes will be erected in Toronto, Ontario. The maximum height is 421 feet above ground level (AGL) or 692 feet above sea level (ASL). The structures will be lighted, but not painted.

The cranes will be located within a 225-foot radius centred at the following coordinates:

43° 39' 15" N 79° 21' 48" W

Multiple cranes are approximately 2 nautical miles (NM) north east (NE) of Toronto/Billy Bishop Toronto City Airport (CYTZ) and 0.7 (NM) east (E) of Toronto St. Michael's Hospital Heliport (CTM4). Details of any procedure changes implemented due to this crane activity will be promulgated via NOTAM, publication amendment, or both.
