

AIP CANADA (ICAO) SUPPLEMENT 19/20

MULTIPLE CRANES—TORONTO, ONTARIO

Multiple cranes will be erected in Toronto, Ontario. The maximum height is 591 feet above ground level (AGL) or 870 feet above sea level (ASL). The structures will be lighted, but not painted.

The cranes will be located within a 215-foot radius centered at the following coordinates:

43° 38' 44" N 79° 23' 26" W

The multiple cranes are approximately 1,340 feet before threshold 26 and 5,170 feet north of the extended runway centre line (RCL) of Toronto/Billy Bishop Toronto City Airport (CYTZ). Details of any procedure changes implemented due to this crane activity will be promulgated via NOTAM, publication amendment, or both.
