

## AIP CANADA (ICAO) SUPPLEMENT 54/20

### CRANES—WITHIN 30 NAUTICAL MILES OF CALGARY/YYC CALGARY INTL AIRPORT

The following cranes will be erected within 30 nautical miles (NM) of Calgary/YYC Calgary Intl (CYYC).

An excerpt of aerodrome location indicators and names used in this supplement is taken from the *Canada Flight Supplement (CFS)*, *Canada Water Aerodrome Supplement (CWAS)* or both and a list of the abbreviations of compass directions are found in the appendix on the last page of this submission.
