

AIP CANADA (ICAO) SUPPLEMENT 79/20

QUEBEC REGION MONTREAL / ST-HUBERT AIRPORT (CYHU) MOBILE CRANES—SEPTEMBER 2020 TO JUNE 2021

The use of mobile cranes located southeast of the St-Hubert airport will start September 21st 2020 and will go on until late May / early June. The maximum height of the cranes will be 140 feet above ground level (AGL) or approximately 220 feet above sea level (ASL). Those works will allow the construction of a new building and will necessitate the use of up to 4 mobile cranes within the area indicated by a red rectangle on the chart below. This building is located at approximately 6000 feet before the runway 28 threshold.

Those cranes will be in use daily on weekdays between 06h00 and 17h00 local time, occasionally at night or on weekends by NOTAM. The cranes will be lighted and marked. No impact on the daily airport operations.

The coordinates of the center of the building are the following:
