

AIP CANADA SUPPLEMENT 084/2026

TRANSPORT CANADA RESTRICTED AIRSPACE CORRIDORS SURROUNDING IQUALUIT, NU (CYFB)

**IMPORTANT: This AIP SUP is for situational awareness only.
NOTAMs are published in conjunction and take precedence**

5 October to 30 October 2026 (Estimated)

Pursuant to section 5.1 of the Aeronautics Act, temporary restricted airspace corridors will be created surrounding Iqaluit International Airport, NU (CYFB) to support Canadian Coast Guard – Aircraft Services Directorate (CCG-ASD) training and operations utilizing a Class 3 Medium-Altitude-Long-Endurance (MALE) Remotely Piloted Aircraft (RPA).

NOTAMs will be issued indicating the effective times of the restricted areas pursuant to section 5.1 of the Aeronautics Act as well as any last-minute changes. The airspace may be deactivated daily when not in use. Areas are to be considered active unless stated otherwise.

No person shall operate an aircraft, including a remotely piloted aircraft (RPA), such as a drone, within the areas described unless authorized by the Montreal area control centre (ACC) on 134.55 MHz or at 1-800-633-1353 for volumes within Class E airspace, or by Canadian Coast Guard Aircraft Services at 613-720-9492. Authorization to enter will be granted when there is no risk of conflict with the RPA.

Restricted Area

Section 5.1 of the *Aeronautics Act* states that:

“The Minister or any person authorized by the Minister may by notice prohibit or restrict the operation of aircraft on or over any area or within any airspace, either absolutely or subject to any exceptions or conditions that the Minister or person may specify [...]”

Pursuant to section 5.1 of the Aeronautics Act, the following restricted areas are planned:

Iqaluit Control Zone (Class E airspace)

The Iqaluit control zone consists of a 5 nautical mile (NM) radius centered on the Iqaluit International Airport, NU (CYFB) (coordinates: 63° 45' 23" N 68° 33' 21" W) from the surface to 3,100 feet mean sea level (MSL).

The control zone will be restricted to non-participating traffic when occupied by the RPA.

Iqaluit Transition Area (Class E airspace)

The Iqaluit transition area consists of a 40 nautical mile (NM) radius centred on the Frobay, NU - NDB (coordinates: 63° 44' 00" N 68° 32' 53" W) from 700 ft to 12,500 feet mean sea level (MSL).

Four (4) corridors will be established to facilitate departure and arrival of the RPA from/to CYFB, referred to as areas LIMA, MIKE, OSCAR, and PAPA.

Authorization to enter may be requested from Montreal Area Control Centre (ACC) on 134.55 MHz or at 1-800-633-1353 for volumes within Class E airspace

Area LIMA (from 2,000 feet MSL to 5,000 feet MSL)

The airspace within the area bounded by a line beginning at:

63° 38' 20" N	68° 33' 30" W	to

Area MIKE (from 3,000 feet MSL to 5,000 feet MSL)

63° 12' 37" N	67° 37' 47" W	to
63° 25' 50" N	68° 06' 10" W	point of beginning.

Area OSCAR (from 2,000 feet MSL to 5,000 feet MSL)

The airspace within the area bounded by a line beginning at:

63° 48' 01" N	68° 42' 55" W	to
63° 49' 06" N	68° 46' 54" W	to
64° 06' 04" N	68° 56' 06" W	to
64° 08' 21" N	68° 33' 54" W	to
63° 51' 22" N	68° 24' 55" W	to
63° 49' 37" N	68° 27' 23" W	point of beginning.

Area PAPA (from 4,000 feet MSL to 10,000 feet MSL)

The airspace within the area bounded by a line beginning at:

64° 21' 20" N	69° 04' 32" W	to
62° 23' 37" N	68° 42' 08" W	to
64° 08' 21" N	68° 33' 54" W	to
64° 06' 04" N	68° 56' 06" W	point of beginning.
00° 00' 00" N	00° 00' 00" W	

Class G Airspace

Two additional corridors will be established outside the transition area to facilitate operational requirements, referred to as areas November and Quebec.

Authorization to enter may be requested from Canadian Coast Guard Aircraft Services at 613-720-9492.

Area QUEBEC (from 9,000 feet MSL to 11,000 feet MSL)

The airspace within the area bounded by a line beginning at:

64° 22' 47" N	68° 53' 30" W	to
66° 00' 00" N	71° 56' 44" W	to
69° 00' 00" N	00° 00' 00" W	to
72° 00' 00" N	74° 42' 00" W	to
72° 20' 17" N	75° 03' 56" W	point of beginning.

Area NOVEMBER (from 4,000 feet MSL to 20,000 feet MSL)

The airspace within the area bounded by a line beginning at:

63° 19' 39" N	67° 22' 04" W	to
63° 28' 32" N	67° 10' 17" W	to
63° 11' 38" N	66° 35' 01" W	to
62° 58' 00" N	67° 07' 08" W	to
63° 12' 37" N	67° 37' 47" W	point of beginning.

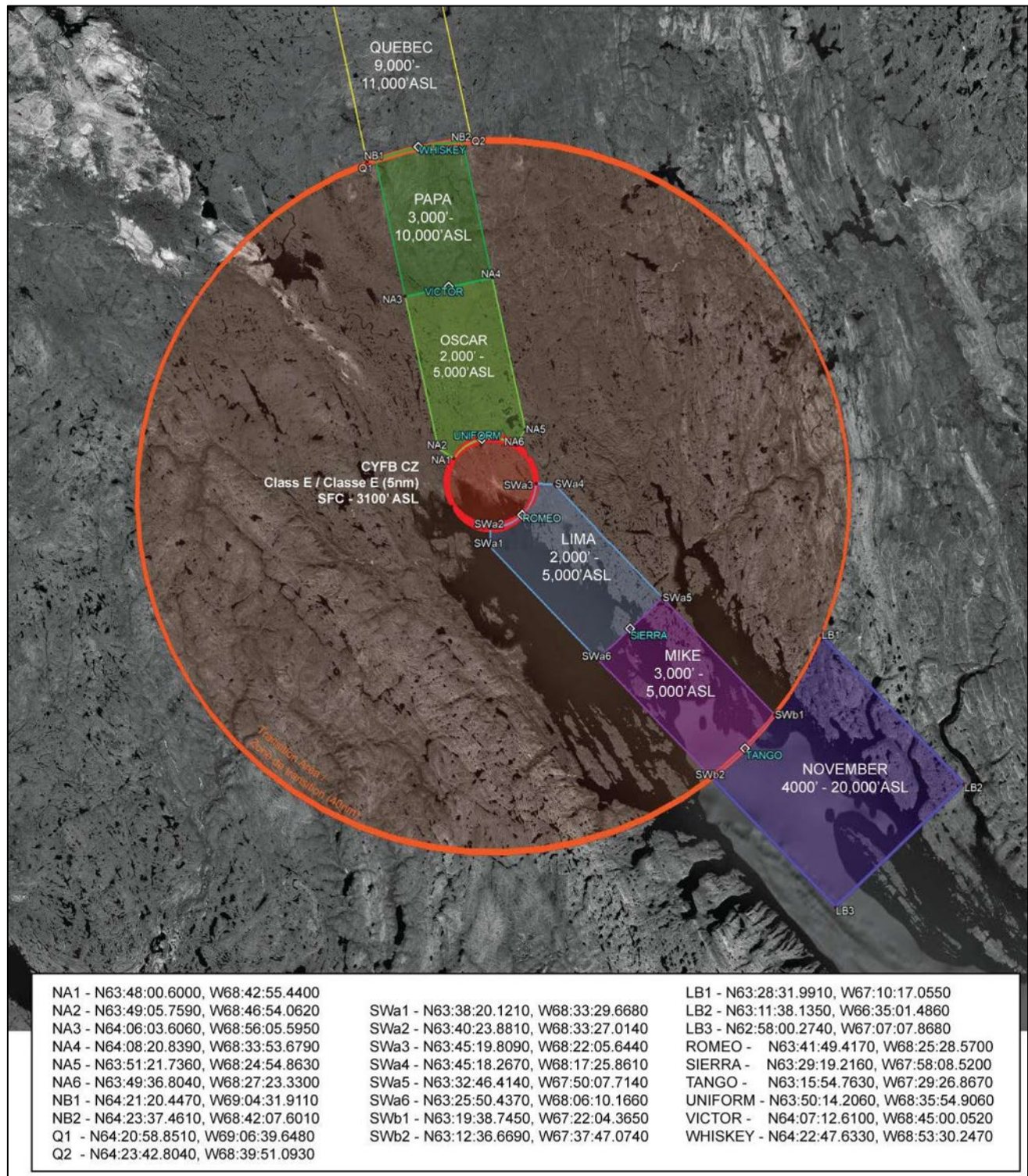


Figure 1. Areas surrounding CYFB – NOT FOR NAVIGATION

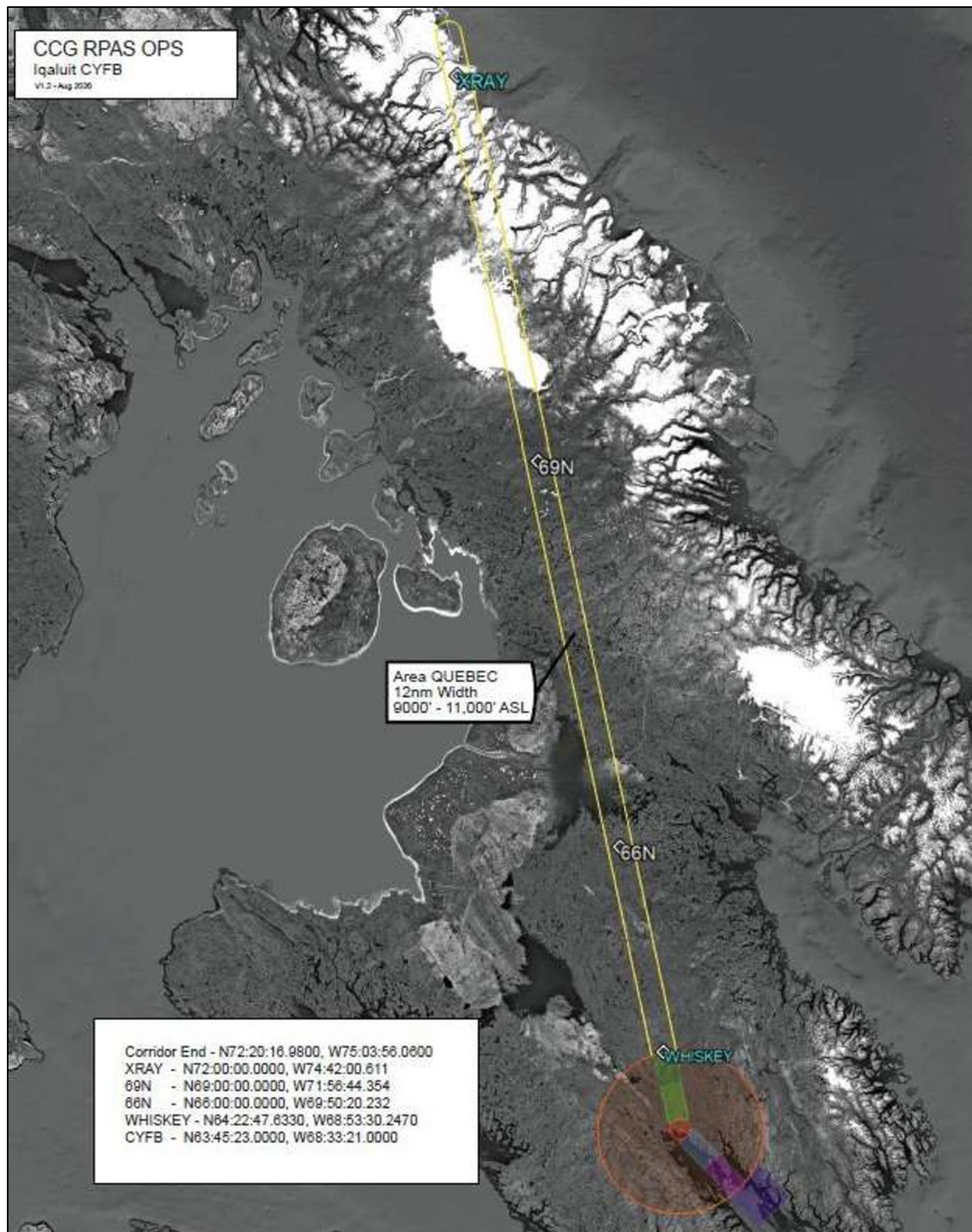


Figure 2. Area QUEBEC – NOT FOR NAVIGATION
