

AERONAUTICAL INFORMATION CIRCULAR 30/21

OVERNIGHT AIR TRAFFIC SERVICE RED DEER REGIONAL AIRPORT, ALBERTA (CYQF)

NAV CANADA, the country's provider of civil air navigation services, conducted an aeronautical study that reviewed the air traffic service (ATS) requirements during the overnight hours at Red Deer Regional Airport, Alberta (CYQF).

The study concluded that the minimal traffic activity during the overnight hours did not warrant on-site ATS.

Airport advisory service (AAS) and vehicle control service (VCS) will be discontinued outside of tower hours from 0500Z to 1300Z local time (0400Z to 1200Z daylight savings time) and the control zone will revert to a mandatory frequency (MF). Aviation weather information will be provided 24 hours per day by the current Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS).

This change will take effect 2 December 2021 at 0901 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC). The appropriate aeronautical publications will be amended.
