

AIP CANADA SUPPLEMENT 32/21

QUEBEC REGION ROUYN-NORANDA AIRPORT (CYUY) CONSTRUCTION WORK: SUMMER 2021

From end of May 2021 to beginning of August 2021, asphalt resurfacing work for Phase 4 to Phase 7 will take place on Taxiway Alfa and Taxiway Bravo and the Apron.

Consult the NOTAM in effect for details on construction work progress and surface area closures.

The pavement rehabilitation works at Rouyn-Noranda airport (CYUY) are divided into 7 distinct phases. Phase 1 to Phase 3 were completed in summer 2020. Phase 4 to Phase 7 will be completed in summer 2021.

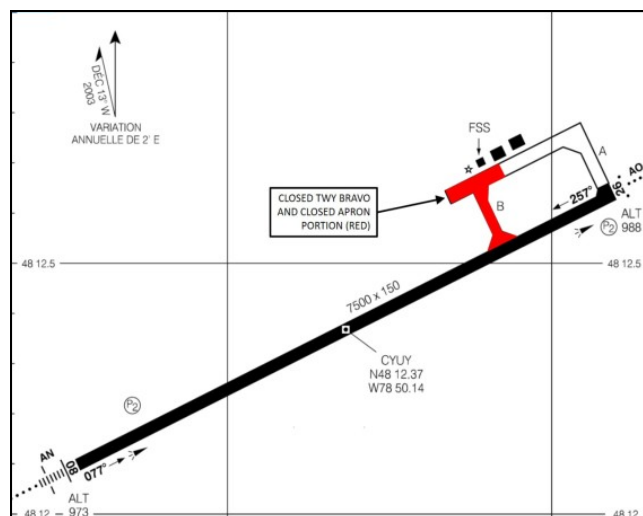


Figure 1: Construction Work for Phase 4 and Phase 5.

Construction Work for Phase 4 (see Figure 1)

- Runway available full length (7,500 feet) – aircraft group number (AGN) IV.
- Rehabilitation work on Taxiway Bravo.
- Taxiway Bravo closed.

Construction Work for Phase 5 (see Figure 1)

- Runway available full length (7,500 feet) – AGN IV.
- Rehabilitation work on the western half of the Apron. Temporary parking positions will be assigned to scheduled operators depending on Apron surfaces affected by work.
- Taxiway Bravo closed.

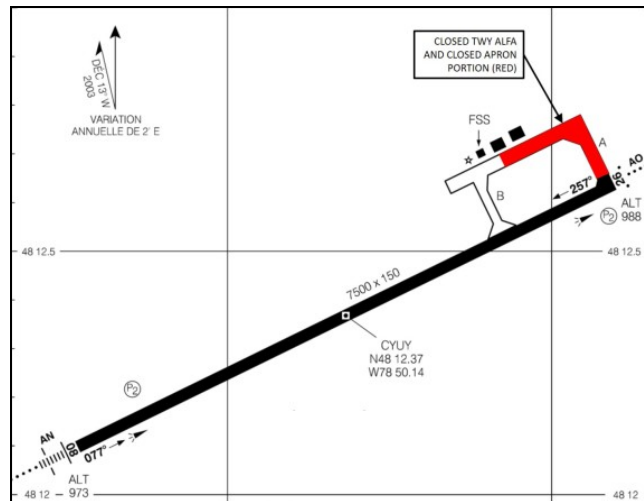


Figure 2: Construction Work for Phase 6.

Construction Work for Phase 6 (see Figure 2)

- Runway available full length (7,500 feet) – AGN IV.
- Rehabilitation work on the eastern half of the Apron. Temporary parking positions will be assigned to scheduled operators depending on Apron surfaces affected by work.
- Taxiway Alfa closed.

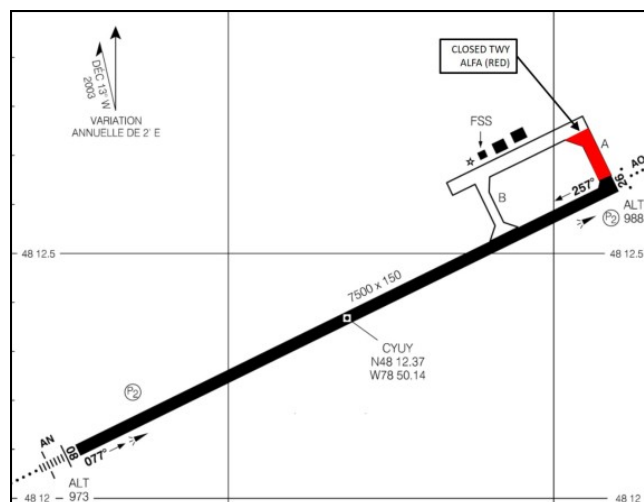


Figure 3: Construction Work for Phase 7.

Construction Work for Phase 7 (see Figure 3)

- Runway available full length (7,500 feet) – AGN IV.
- Rehabilitation work on Taxiway Alfa.
- Taxiway Alfa closed.
