## CONSTRUCTION AT: MONTREAL/PIERRE ELLIOTT TRUDEAU INTL (CYUL) 14 MARCH 2022 TO 23 JUNE 2022

### Runway 06L/24R Construction Work

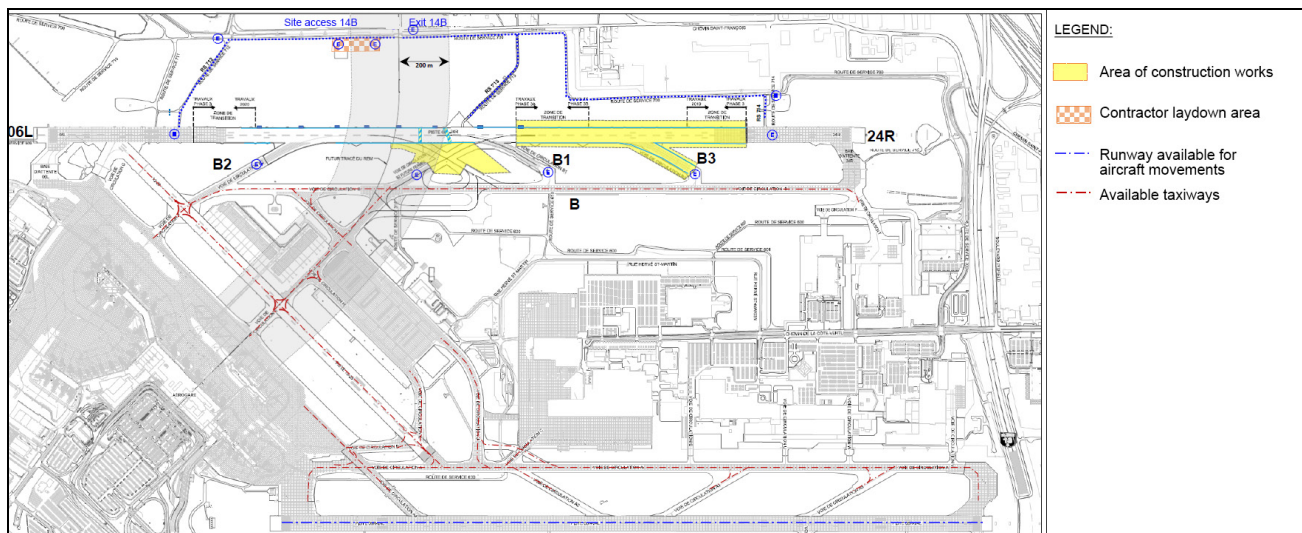
Montreal-Trudeau International Airport (CYUL) will commence the following construction work, starting 14 March 2022:

- Runway pavement rehabilitation using concrete slabs.
- Taxiway B3 rehabilitation.
- Excavation, drainage, and granular sub-base work between future Taxiways B2 and B1.
- Electrical work (trenches, electrical conduits, etc.).

**Construction activities will run continuously for the entire duration of the work.**

### Impacts on Operations

- Runway 06L/24R closed via NOTAM for the entire duration of the work.
- Taxiways B1, B2, and B3 closed via NOTAM for the entire duration of the work.
- Approach lights and runway edge lights for Runway 06L/24R will be disconnected.
- Low-visibility operations plan (LVOP) and CAT II procedures will be unavailable for the duration of the work.
