CONCLUSION OF ASSESSMENT

Gatineau, Quebec - Air Traffic Service and Aviation Weather Requirements

Pursuant to Section 15 of the Civil Air Navigation Services Commercialization Act, S.C. 1996, c. 20 (the ANS Act), the Notice of Proposal period, regarding NAV CANADA's amendment of civil air navigation services at Gatineau, Quebec, has concluded.

NAV CANADA has reviewed the representations received from stakeholders and other participants regarding the proposed amendment. The evaluation confirmed that all relevant information had been appropriately submitted at earlier stages of the aeronautical study process.

As a result, NAV CANADA will now engage Transport Canada for regulatory review on the following amendments to civil air navigation services:

- 1) Adjust and increase the FSS and MF hours to 15 hours daily from 1215Z to 0315Z±,
- 2) Install an AWOS and ATIS,

In addition, the study recommends the following changes – that can be implemented outside the Aeronautical Study process – be pursued:

- 3) Develop VTPC revisions, and,
- 4) Implement a training slot system,
