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CONCLUSION OF ASSESSMENT

Kelowna, British Columbia - Airspace and Air Traffic Service Requirements

Pursuant to Section 15 of the Civil Air Navigation Services Commercialization Act, S.C. 1996, c. 20 (the ANS Act), the Notice of Proposal period, regarding NAV CANADA's amendment of civil air navigation services in the vicinity of Kelowna, British Columbia, has concluded.

NAV CANADA has examined the representations received from stakeholders and other participants concerning the proposed amendment.

As a result, NAV CANADA will now engage Transport Canada for regulatory review on the following amendments to civil air navigation services:

- Modification of the Kelowna Control Zone (CZ), adding a shelf at the north and south end of the CZ, and redesignating the CZ as Class C airspace,
- Extending a portion of CYA 122 to the west from the surface to 4,500 feet ASL, and adding a flight training symbol to the CYA description,
- Elimination of the Alpine, Valhalla, and Wildcat Helicopter Air Traffic Frequency (ATF) areas and establishing a single ATF area for helicopters in West Kelowna, and depicting it on the VFR Terminal Procedures Chart (VTPC). Changing the Ikon Adventures ATF frequency to 126.7,
- Exploring revision and updating of the Kelowna VTPC, including VFR routes and waypoints.
