



# NOTICE OF CHANGE

## Change in Aviation Weather Observing Program

### Pickle Lake, Ontario

NAV CANADA, the country's provider of civil air navigation services, conducted an aeronautical study that reviewed the requirements for the aviation weather service provided at the Pickle Lake airport.

The study recommended that the contract weather office (CWO) be replaced with a NAV CANADA Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS). The AWOS installation will include a Voice Generator Sub-System (VGSS) and digital aviation weather cameras.

AWOS information will be broadcast via the VGSS on a VHF frequency and weather camera images of the airport and surrounding area will be viewable on the NAV CANADA Aviation Weather Website. This change will provide 24-hour per day aerodrome routine meteorological reports/aerodrome special meteorological reports (METAR/SPECI) and increase the 12-hour Aerodrome Forecast (TAF) to 24 hour.

This change will take effect **15 August 2019 at 0901 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC)**. The appropriate aeronautical publications will be amended.
