**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
Nanaimo, British Columbia**

GENERAL

Pursuant to Section 15 of the Civil Air Navigation Services Commercialization Act, S.C. 1996, c. 20 (the ANS Act), this document provides notice of NAV CANADA's proposal to amend civil air navigation services in the vicinity of Nanaimo, British Columbia.

Persons interested in making representations to NAV CANADA about the proposal set out in this Notice may do so by writing to the address set out under Section 2. Such representations must be received by NAV CANADA no later than January 25, 2023.

This Notice consists of two Sections:

- (1) Particulars of the Proposal
- (2) Making Representations to NAV CANADA.

1. PARTICULARS OF THE PROPOSAL

Following the conduct of an Aeronautical Study, NAV CANADA proposes the following amendments to civil air navigation services in the vicinity of Nanaimo Airport, British Columbia:

- Replacing Airport Advisory Service with 13.75 hour per day Airport Control Service at Nanaimo Airport during the hours 1430Z to 0415Z† (0630 to 2015 local).
- Changing the lateral dimensions and airspace classification of the Nanaimo Airport Control Zone.
- Changing the Nanaimo Harbour Aerodrome Traffic Frequency (ATF) area to a Mandatory Frequency (MF) area.
- Changing the lateral dimensions of Advisory Airspace areas CYA 113 and CYA 118.
- Increasing surveillance in a 5 NM radius of both the Nanaimo Harbour and Nanaimo Airport;
- Introducing an Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS) at Nanaimo Airport.
- Introducing a Limited Weather Information System (LWIS) and visibility sensor at Nanaimo Harbour water aerodrome.
- Introducing Class E and Class C Transition Areas (TA) to contain the current and planned IFR procedures for runway 16 and runway 34.
- Introducing a Terminal Class C Route and signing agreements with float plane operators providing scheduled service to Nanaimo Harbour to permit access to Class C airspace for VFR OTT flights.
