## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

Gatineau, Quebec - Addendum - Air Traffic Service and Aviation Weather Requirements

### **GENERAL**

Pursuant to Section 15 of the Civil Air Navigation Services Commercialization Act, S.C. 1996, c. 20 (the ANS Act), this document provides notice of NAV CANADA's proposal to amend civil air navigation services at Gatineau, Quebec.

Persons interested in making representations to NAV CANADA about the proposal set out in this Notice may do so by writing to the address set out under Section 2. NAV CANADA must receive representations no later than August 17, 2026.

This Notice consists of two Sections:

- (1) Particulars of the Proposal
- (2) Making Representations to NAV CANADA.

### **1. PARTICULARS OF THE PROPOSAL**

Based on the Aeronautical Study Addendum assessment, NAV CANADA proposes the following amendments to civil air navigation services in the vicinity of the Gatineau Airport, Quebec:

- Provision of airport control service in the Gatineau Control Zone (CZ) 13 hours per day from 1230Z to 0130Z (0730 to 2030 local) during standard time, and 16 hours per day from 1030Z to 0230Z (0630 to 2230 local) during daylight savings time (DST) and a change to the CZ airspace classification from Class E to Class D,
- Designate the Gatineau CZ as an MF area outside of airport control service hours,
- Modify the lower limit of the mode C transponder mandatory airspace described in the Designated Handbook under section 3.5.5-19 from 2,500 feet ASL to 1,500 feet ASL,
- Installation of certified ATC Grade Video equipment to allow visual monitoring of the portion of Taxiway B that is not visible from the tower cab,
- Following AWOS equipment installation, increase the Aerodrome Forecast (TAF) period to 1100Z to 0500Z.
