## Canadian ADS-B OUT Performance Requirement Mandate

### Aeronautical Study Update

NAV CANADA, the country's provider of civil air navigation services, is conducting an aeronautical study to deliberate the requirement for a Canadian Automatic Dependent Surveillance – Broadcast (ADS-B) OUT performance requirement mandate. By using space-based ADS-B aircraft surveillance can be enhanced, which will allow air traffic control (ATC) to safely reduce aircraft separation resulting in improved operational efficiency.
