

AIP CANADA SUPPLEMENT 61/22

CONSTRUCTION AT: MONTREAL/PIERRE ELLIOTT TRUDEAU INTL (CYUL) 17 OCTOBER 2022 TO 11 NOVEMBER 2022

Runway 06L/24R Construction Work

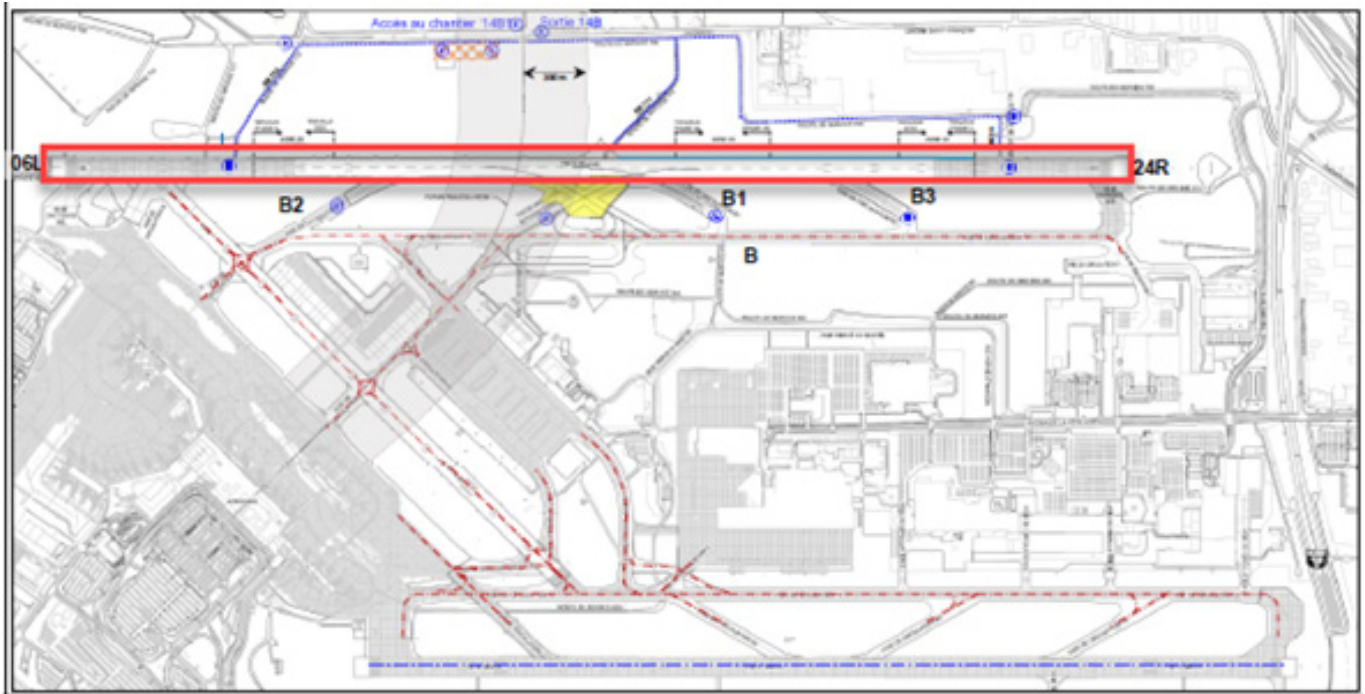






Figure 1: Runway 06L/24R Construction Work

Montreal/Pierre Elliott Trudeau Intl (CYUL) will commence the following construction work, starting 17 October 2022 (also see Figure 1 on the following page):

- Excavation, drainage, and installation of a manhole and a pipe network between future Taxiway B2 and Taxiway B1.
- Electrical work (connection of the temperature sensor close to the circulation path Taxiway B3, etc.).

Construction activities will run continuously for the entire duration of the work, with the following impacts on operations:

- Runway 06L/24R closed via NOTAM for the entire duration of the work.
- Taxiways B1, B2 (between Taxiway B and Runway 06L/24R), and B3 closed via NOTAM for the entire duration of the work.
- Approach lights and runway edge lights for Runway 06L/24R will be disconnected.
- Low-visibility operations plan (LVOP) and CAT II procedures will be unavailable for the duration of the work.
