

# AIP CANADA SUPPLEMENT 65/22

## CARGO APRONS AT VANCOUVER INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (CYVR)

### Introduction

Vancouver International Airport (CYVR) is expanding and making some changes to the cargo-related aprons.

### New Requirements and Restrictions

- Added Aprons IV, V, VIII to the list of aprons with the following requirements:
  - Prior permission required (PPR) Airport Ops is necessary.
  - PPR for all engine air starts or cross-bleed starts.
- Apron IV: Restricted to B757/A321 and smaller.
- Aircraft stand taxilane east of DW: Restricted to Convair CV-580 and smaller.
- Apron VIII: Restricted to B767/A310 and smaller.
- Between FedEx and Purolator aprons: Restricted to Fairchild Swearingen Metroliner and smaller.

### Aircraft Stand Renumbering

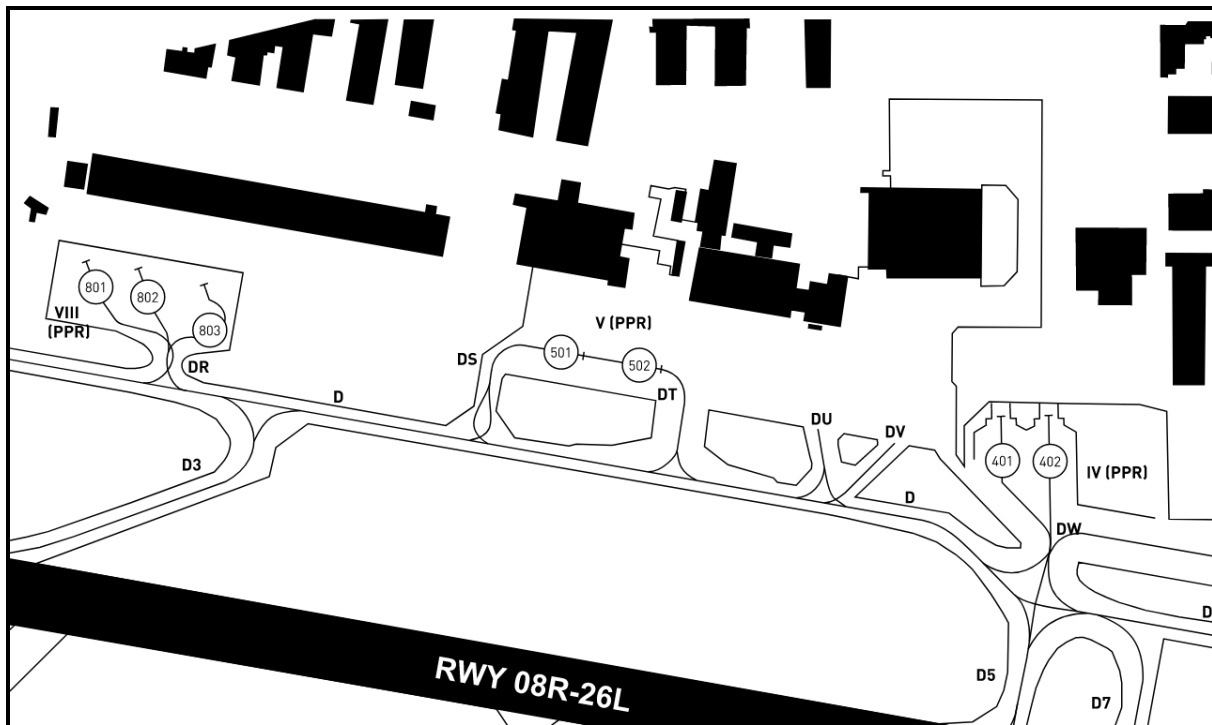


Figure 1: Aircraft Stand Renumbering

The aircraft stands on Aprons IV, V, and VIII have been renumbered, as shown in Figure 1 below.

## New Apron Labels

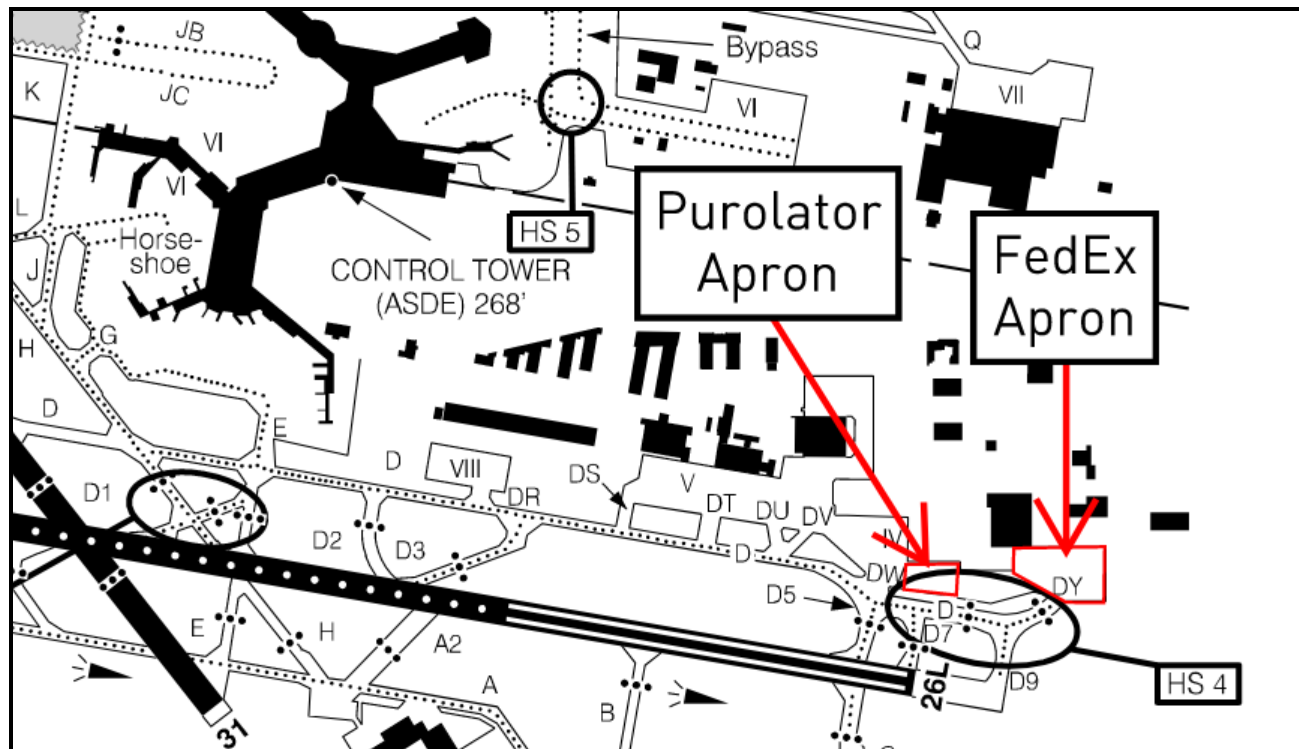


Figure 2: New Apron Labels

The Purolator and FedEx aprons will be labeled, as shown in Figure 2 below.
