

# AIP CANADA SUPPLEMENT 10/23

## CONSTRUCTION AT MONTREAL/PIERRE ELLIOTT TRUDEAU INTL (CYUL) 13 MARCH 2023 TO 23 JUNE 2023

### Runway 06L/24R Construction Work

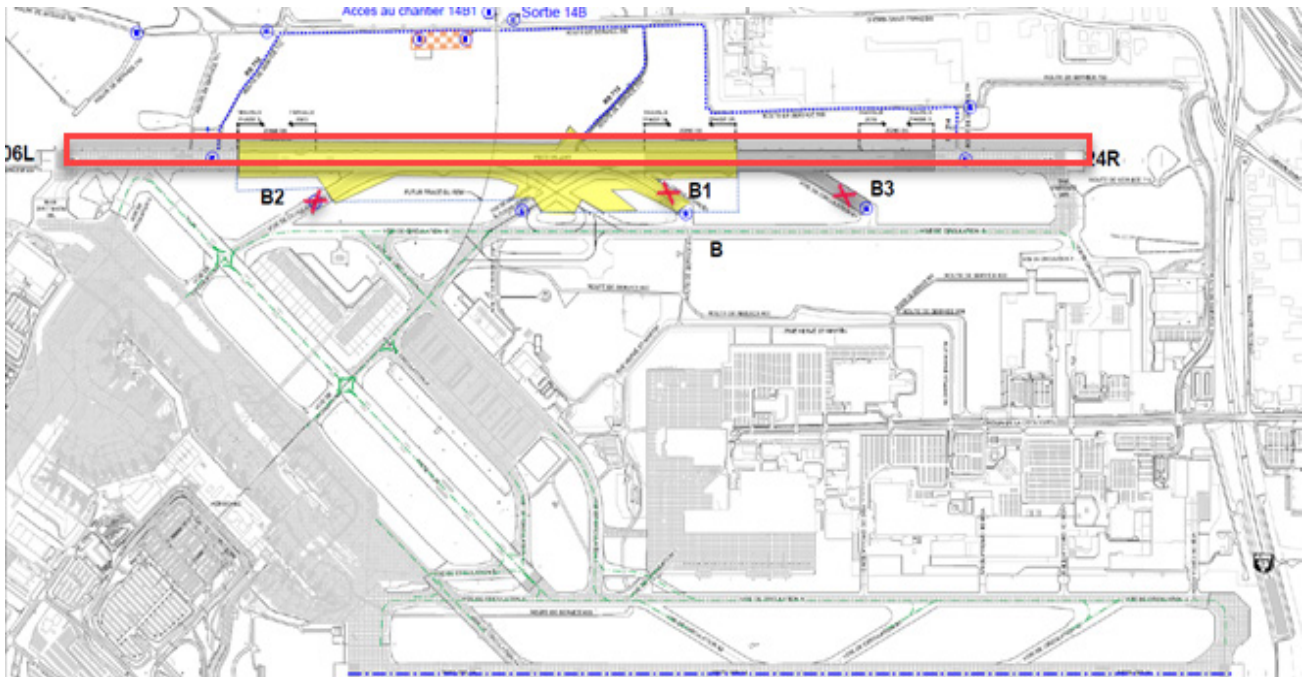






Figure 1: Runway 06L/24R Construction Work

Montreal/Pierre Elliott Trudeau Intl (CYUL) will commence the following construction work, starting **13 March 2023** (see Figure 1 on the following page):

- Runway pavement rehabilitation, including concrete slab replacement between future Taxiway B2 and Taxiway B1
- Rehabilitation of Taxiway B2 and B1
- Construction of new high speed exit taxiway

Construction activities will run continuously for the entire duration of the work, with the following impacts on operations:

- Runway 06L/24R closed via NOTAM for the entire duration of the work
- Taxiway B2 North of Taxiway B closed via NOTAM for the entire duration of the work
- Taxiways B1 and B3 closed via NOTAM for the entire duration of the work
- Approach lights and runway edge lights for Runway 06L/24R will be disconnected
- Low-visibility operations plan (LVOP) and CAT II procedures will be unavailable for the duration of the work
