CONCLUSION OF ASSESSMENT

Review of Communication and Aviation Weather Service Requirements at Aerodromes with Community Aerodrome Radio Stations in Yukon

Pursuant to Section 15 of the Civil Air Navigation Services Commercialization Act, S.C. 1996, c. 20 (the ANS Act), the Notice of Proposal period, regarding NAV CANADA's amendment of civil air navigation services at Beaver Creek, Burwash, Dawson City, Faro, Old Crow et Teslin, Yukon, is now concluded.

NAV CANADA has reviewed the representations received from stakeholders and other participants regarding the proposed amendment.

The evaluation identified new information that had not previously been provided during the earlier stages of the aeronautical study process. This information has been considered in the assessment.

As a result, NAV CANADA will now engage Transport Canada for regulatory review on the following amendments to civil air navigation services:

- 1) Beaver Creek (CYXQ)**
 - a) Close the CARS on weekends during the seven-month period October 1 to April 30 and on all Federal observed holidays; and
 - b) Install three digital aviation weather cameras (DAWC).

- 2) Burwash (CYDB)**
 - a) Upgrade the telecommunication infrastructure at the Burwash aerodrome;
 - b) Reduce the hours of operation of the CARS to 8 hours per day for the period May 1 to September 30 and 6 hours per day from October 1 to April 30;
 - c) Close the CARS on weekends during the seven-month period October 1 to April 30 and on all Federal observed holidays;
 - d) Retain the Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS) to conduct the aviation weather observations 24 hours per day; and
 - e) Maintain the current 24-hour per day aerodrome forecast (TAF) coverage.

- 3) Dawson City (CYDA)**
 - a) Increase the hours of operation of the Dawson City CARS to 17 hours per day during the period May 1 to September 30 to 1200 to 0500Z (0500 to 2200 local time).

- 4) Faro (CZFA)**
 - a) Close the CARS on Federal observed holidays.

- 5) Old Crow (CYOC)
 - a) Close the CARS;
 - b) Install an AWOS to provide weather observations 24 hours per day; and
 - c) Increase of the TAF coverage to 15 hours per day (1300 to 0500Z (0600 to 2200 local time).

- 6) Teslin (CYZW)
 - a) Close the CARS;
 - b) Install AWOS to provide weather observations 24 hours per day;
 - c) Increase the period of TAF coverage to 16 hours 1500 to 0700Z (0800 to 2400 local time);
and
 - d) Install a flight information service – enroute (FISE) remote communications outlet (RCO) at Teslin to allow pilots to communicate with the Whitehorse Flight Information Centre (FIC) staff at 7,000 feet above sea level (ASL) within 40 NM of Teslin.
